Job Title: Multi-Faith Chaplaincy Coordinator

#### Job Purpose:

To provide opportunities for spiritual and moral development for our diverse learner body in order to engender an environment based on respect, tolerance and an understanding of individuals' views

## Main Responsibilities:

- Co-ordinate a faith programme that supports learners' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development
- Liaise with a range of multi-faith groups in order to develop an awareness of contemporary cultural, faith and belief issues and the effect these have on their local communities
- Establish partnerships that may create opportunities for alternative funding
- Contribute to the work of the Equality and Diversity Committee
- Provide group and one-to-one pastoral support as appropriate
- Co-ordinate cross-college commemoration events. e.g. Armistice Day, Holocaust Memorial Day etc.
- Co-ordinate activities that celebrate multi-faith religious events and festivals e.g. Diwali, Christmas.
- Advise management on specific issues of faith, e.g. dietary requirements, prayer facilities, timetabling during religious festivals and events
- Develop policy on protocol for dealing with specific situations e.g. death of a learner
- Contribute to the college tutorial provision
- Assume a lead role in advising on the management on any tensions that may arise as a result of multi-faith communities within the college
- Represent the college at appropriate external events
- Conduct other duties commensurate with post as guided by your line manager
